REMOTE LEARNING STUDENT EXPECTATIONS...

1. TREAT ONLINE LEARNING THE SAME AS CLASSROOM LESSONS...

Despite being at home, remember that the same rules apply as being in the classroom, particularly with behaviour and conduct.

Work hard, think for yourself and follow the teacher's instructions!

2. USE CLASSROOM LANGUAGE

If you need to communicate, on camera, microphone or email – remember to not use text speak and write and speak as if you would in the classroom.

Always be respectful and polite!

3. ONLY COMMUNICATE USING SCHOOL PLATFORMS

It's important that you send messages and work through school approved channels, such as your school email, teams & frog.

This will help you keep your personal information safe and secure!

4. DON'T SHARE PASSWORDS !

To join and take part in your online lessons – you will need your school email and password.

Never share your login details with others, and always keep them private!

5. DON'T USE SCHOOL PLATFORMS TO DISCUSS PERSONAL MATTERS

Try to keep your school communication channels separate from your own personal communications with friends etc.

Don't be tempted to engage in casual discussions, send images/videos using school platforms that aren't associated with your learning.

6. LOOK AFTER YOUR MENTAL HEALTH & WELLBEING!

Remote learning can often mean working alone and missing out on daily social interaction with your friends in class.

If you feel frustrated, low or sad, it's important to discuss how you feel with your family/teacher.
