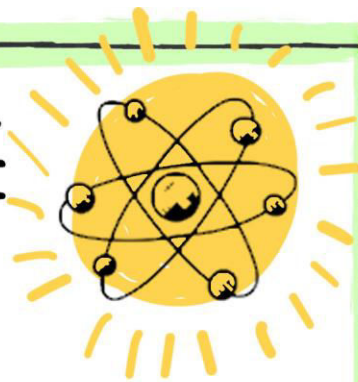


SUMMER TASKS:
