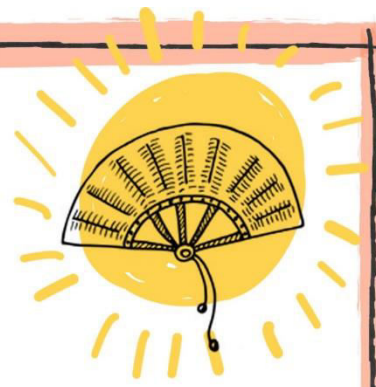


# SUMMER TASKS:

# SPANISH YEAR 8



## TASK ONE

Watch the Spanish film **Carol's journey** on the media server <https://videosever.macmillan-academy.org.uk/View.aspx?id=15327~5f~xexGbHDKGK> about a 12 year-old girl who goes to visit her family's hometown in Spain with her terminally ill mother, during the Civil War in 1938. Create a fact file or a mind map about Carol and Tomiche.
